

As a Prophetic Intercessor what do you see God doing in America, spiritually, politically and economically? How do you see the funding of the gospel in the End-Time unfolding? How will the Glory play apart of the transfer of wealth like it did when the Jews left Egypt?

What I see God doing in America

- a. **Spiritually** I see God working in the hearts and lives of believers to examine themselves to be worthy of the true riches of Christianity that is a full understanding and operational awareness of the power of the Holy Spirit ie Tongues, Words of knowledge, Revelation of Scriptures, Prophetic, Miracles with Signs and Wonders along with a renewed desire to establish and maintain designated” Prayer Altars” for the purpose of developing a intimate relationship with Jesus through Prayer and Communion.
- b. **Politically** I see God placing people in positions throughout America to establish Kingdom principles that will set the stage for end time awakening, transformation and Reformation.
- c. **Economically** Oh yes! This one has great importance to both God and Believers. To God it’s very important because it serves as a test to believers to determine if they can truly serve only one Master. The test is “do you love God and use money?” or “do you love money and use God?”

How do I see the funding of the gospel in the End-Time unfolding?

How will the Glory play apart of the transfer of wealth like it did when the Jews left Egypt?

Before these questions can be answered, I feel we must answer a tougher question!

“If we are joint heirs with Jesus to the Blessings of Abraham which is no debt-no lack- always increasing- unlimited supply...then why is so much of the Church struggling with debt, lack of resources, facing decreasing financial stability and finding themselves short of supply while trying to accomplish what God called them to do?

I believe that if we take a close look at the Covenant that God made with Abraham we will find the solutions to funding the gospel. I believe the scriptures reveal the funding mechanisms by understanding and operating in and with the” Blessings of Abraham.”

The Abrahamic Covenant is the Covenant God made with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. It was made after the tower of Babel and the scattering of the descendant of Noah. It involves national Israel, the Seed Messiah, and all believers of all nations. It is the most comprehensive of all Old Testament Covenants.

Like previous covenants it begins a probation cycle. Man’s probation in relation to the terms. Man’s failure to keep the terms, God’s judgment on sin, and finally God’s redemptive covenant given.

The Words of the Covenant include the Promises of the Covenant (Romans 9:4-5, I Chronicles 16:15-17, Exodus 2:24). The Promises of Personal Blessing (Genesis 12:2). The Blessing of Melchisedek (Genesis 14:19-20). The Blessing of material prosperity (Genesis 13:2; 24:1,35). The Blessing of physical well-being (Romans 4:17-21).

Blessing Others (Genesis 12:2) God said to Abraham “Thou shalt be a blessing” God made it clear to Abraham that the purpose of being blessed was that he might be a blessing to others.

Blessed by others (Genesis 12:3) God also said to Abraham “I will bless them that bless thee.” As a confirmation of His blessing, God promised to bless those who show favor to Abraham.

This promise was confirmed also to Isaac (Genesis 24:51-53), Jacob (Genesis 30:25-43), and Israel (Deuteronomy 28: 1-14).

Messianic Blessing (Genesis 12:3; 22:17-18) God also promised Abraham “in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.” This was the greatest promise of blessing, that through Abraham God would bestow his favor upon all the peoples of the earth. This promise involved the birth of the Seed Messiah, Jesus Christ, and was fulfilled in the New Covenant.

Genesis 18:18 (NLT)¹⁸ **“For Abraham will certainly become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth will be blessed through him.**

Romans 4:9 **Now, is this blessing only for the Jews, or is it also for uncircumcised Gentiles? Well, we have been saying that Abraham was counted as righteous by God because of his faith.**

Galatians 3:9 (NLT)⁹ **So all who put their faith in Christ share the same blessing Abraham received because of his faith**

Galatians 3:14 (NLT)¹⁴ **Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith.**

Acts 3:25 (NLT)²⁵ **You are the children of those prophets, and you are included in the covenant God promised to your ancestors. For God said to Abraham, ‘Through your descendants all the families on earth will be blessed.**

Romans 11:17 (NLT)¹⁷ **But some of these branches from Abraham’s tree—some of the people of Israel—have been broken off. And you Gentiles, who were branches from a wild olive tree, have been grafted in. So now you also receive the blessing God has promised Abraham and his children, sharing in the rich nourishment from the root of God’s special olive tree.**

Galatians 3:8 (NLT)⁸ What's more, the Scriptures looked forward to this time when God would make the Gentiles right in his sight because of their faith. God proclaimed this good news to Abraham long ago when he said, "All nations will be blessed through you."

As you read and understand the Words of the Covenant between God and Abraham it leaves no doubt in my mind that we can sum up the Blessing of Abraham in one statement

"No Debt- No Lack -Always Increasing- Unlimited Supply!!!

What I see in the Glory playing a part in the transfer of wealth we read about in Proverbs 13:22 we must take into consideration the entire book of proverbs and consider it a pattern to live by "do what it says to do and don't do what it says not to do", and as my spiritual father Dick Reuben often reminds me by saying "When you get the pattern right the Glory Will Fall".

We must remember "The Lord caused the Egyptians to look favorably on the Israelites, and they gave the Israelites whatever they asked for. So they stripped the Egyptians of their wealth!" Exodus 12:36 NLT

These are some things to consider when we are striving to get the pattern right.

Am I focused on the problem more than the solution?

Am I chasing money rather than it chasing me?

Am I operating as an empire builder rather than a Kingdom builder?

Am I in pursuit of my will or His will for me?

Am I acting in response to circumstances rather than faith?

Am I anxious about anything?

You may not be eligible for the transfer of wealth:

If everything you do is done for men to see...Matthew 23:5-7

If you rarely share your faith with others...Matthew 10:32-33

If you gage your morality by comparison to others...Luke 18:11-12

If you live in luxury and resist giving to the poor...Matthew 25:32-40

If you live by what you have and not by faith...Luke 12:16-35

If your bank balance determines your attitude...I Timothy 6:6

If you give Jesus less than what he asks of you...Luke 14:31-35

If you don't understand the Kingdom is within you...Luke 17:20-21

If you love money and use God rather than love God and use money...

Matthew 6:24
