<ol> <li>PASSIVE/AGGRESSIVE WIVES. This is were the wife is submissive, but inwardly she is maneuvering to get her way. This becomes a life of manipulations. Outwardly submitting in word, but underneath using things like sex to get one's way.</li> </ol>

Introduction to this section:

Love, Anger & Marriage: "Married couples – the relation of marriage allows for the state of anger more than any other type of relationship – fighting is a given." Marriage is two people combining their problems.

#### **BIBLICAL EXAMPLES**

- 1. Fighting is nothing new It has existed from the fall of man!
  - A. Adam & Eve Genesis 3:8-13 She did it...it's her fault.
  - B. Abraham & Sarah Genesis 21:8-9 Ishmael (16, 17 years old) & Isaac – being weaned.

At home your spouse is your wife and your children's mother; at your in-laws home, she is their daughter, your child's mother, the granddaughter of their parents, and somewhere down the list she's your wife. Roles reverse themselves.

Your emotional allegiance must move from your parents to your spouse. "For this cause shall a man/woman leave his father and mother and cleave to his wife, and the two shall become one.."
